Anime Club



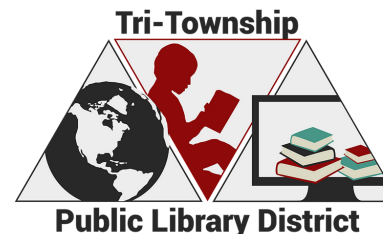
Wednesday, April 17th 5:30-7:00

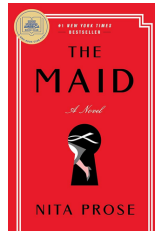

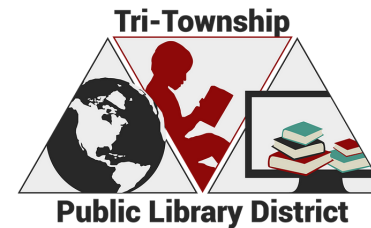
The Scrappy Junk Journal Club

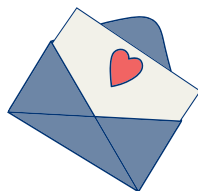

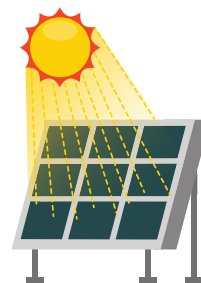
